

- Cooperates closely with the Bonn site of ECMWF and other cooperation partners




Membership

- Cooperate in goals, tasks and administration of CESOC (in accordance with Statute)



- Comply with rules of good scientific practice
- Treat CESOC internal information as confidential if marked accordingly, even after leaving CESOC

 At least one ordinary Members' Assembly per year



- · with following tasks:
 - Receiving the report of Directors' Board and Central Office
 - b) Discuss strategic planning of CESOC, e.g. establishing /dissolving working groups etc.
 - c) Election/deselection of Directors' Board
 - d) Decision of additions or amendments to Statute
